The Kendo Federation of Trinidad & Tobago is organizing this Easter weekend a Seminar and Tournament event bringing to Trinidad for the first time Kendo experts from USA, Venezuela and Aruba. This Japanese fencing event will take place at Jean Pierre Complex on Friday and Saturday and at the Chinese Association (St-Anns) on Sunday. Training sessions will be from 9am-11:30am and 5pm-7pm, and the public is welcome to attend them.

The goal of this groundbreaking event is to expose students of T&T to an international level of Kendo and continue in its mission to promote Kendo across Trinidad & Tobago and the Caribbean. The seminar will be held from Friday morning to Sunday night and will include the participation of Ebihara sensei (7-dan from USA), Velasquez-sensei (6-dan from Aruba), Chan sensei (5-dan from USA) and Pintos sensei (4-dan from Venezuela). Although most of the 3-day seminar will be focusing on traditional Japanese fencing training, individual and team tournaments will be held on Saturday starting at 5pm.

Following a 3rd place finish in the last Caribbean and South American Kendo Cup held in Columbia last year, the team wishes to improve on this result at this year's upcoming tournament held in Caracas in October.

The Kendo Federation of Trinidad & Tobago is the only organization recognized internationally by the Japanese Kendo Federation and other Federations around the world.
